



GARVESTONE AND THUXTON VILLAGE HALL

Temporary Events Notice (TEN)

Alcohol and Extended Hours

Events at which the sale, or provision of alcohol at a ticketed event, is offered require a *specific application* for a Temporary Event Notice to extend the licence conditions of Garvestone & Thuxton Village Hall.

It is the responsibility of the hirer to -

- Apply for this extension;
- To comply with all the requirements;
- To display the notice at the hall for the duration of the event;
- To forward a copy of the TEN certificate to the Booking Secretary **before** the event.

Events that offer alcohol for sale, or where it is provided as part of a charge for attending the event need a TEN

Events where no charge for alcoholic drinks, or entry, is made (for example family parties) do **not** need a TEN
